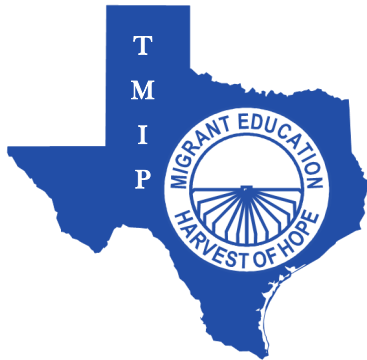

5. Nominator must submit a letter of recommendation to support the student's qualifications.
6. Ensure that application is complete and picture is suitable for printing
7. If final ranking changes, submit updated transcript

- ⇒ Be a valid 2019 graduation candidate
- ⇒ Student must have current and valid COE

- ⇒ Information will be printed as submitted on application
- ⇒ **Deadline: Friday, May 03, 2019**

1. **Submit cap and gown picture** (May be emailed, original pictures will be returned) Do not staple
2. Include current official transcript
3. Provide copy of Certificate of Eligibility (COE)
4. Submit Letter of Recommendation
5. Include detailed Résumé
6. Completed nomination form (no blank sections or missing documents)
