The North Dakota Summer Migrant Education Program offers services to migrant students, from Age 3 through grade 12 and referral services with Tri-Valley, Head Start. Services provided include:

Academics: Students learn reading, math and other subjects in creative and enjoyable classrooms. High school students earn credits toward their graduation.

Recreation: Students participate in recreational activities including swimming.

Health Services: Students receive dental, vision and health screening and will be informed of treatment options.

Supplemental Services: ALL services, including meals and transportation are provided **FREE** of charge to parents.

Distance Education: Children unable to attend our summer migrant schools in Manvel or Grafton can learn through our distance education program.
