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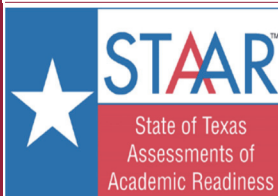
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TMIP: Intra/Interstate Coordination & Out-Of-State Testing for 2018-2019

- ◇ Texas migrant students have the same STAAR testing opportunities as their non-migrant peers while they are in the receiving states
- ◇ The Texas Migrant Interstate Program (TMIP) coordinates the out-of-state administration of the STAAR assessments with receiving states.
- ◇ TMIP trained 62 Test Administrators that were ready to assist if testing was needed in their state.
- ◇ Test Administrators were trained at the National Migrant Education Conference in New Orleans, Louisiana; Via Webinar, Skype, Zoom and Face-to-Face in the Ohio and Illinois Statewide Summer Migrant Conferences.
- ◇ TMIP made contact with 9,885 migrant students through the TMIP intra/interstate coordination efforts.
- ◇ Students referred for testing out-of-state were provided course study guides and/or registered to participate with online tutorials.
- ◇ Of the 9,885 migrant students, 3,493 were identified as Priority for Services (PFS).

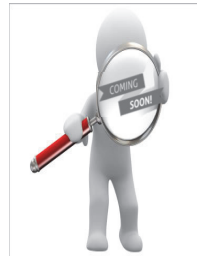
